

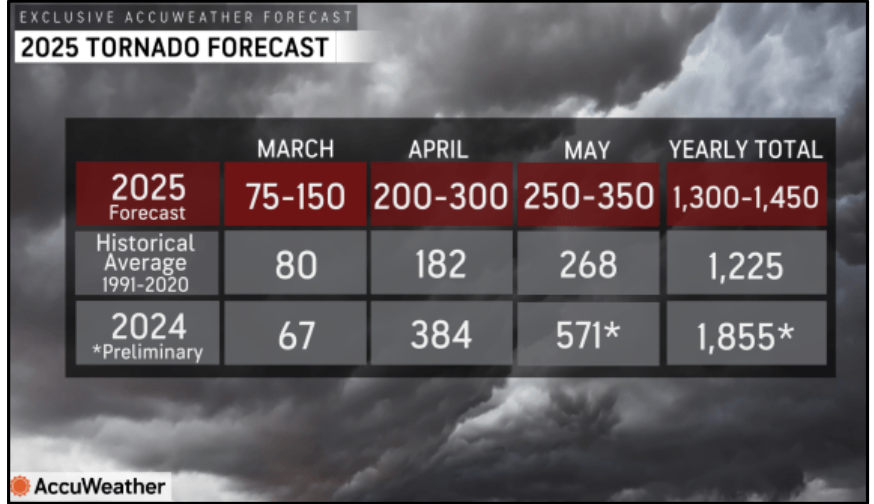

March 6, 2025

2025 Tornado Forecast

- The upcoming season is not expected to be as busy as 2024 tornado season but could still finish above the historical average.
- Severe weather in 2025 will gradually ramp up from March through May.
- AccuWeather is predicting 75 to 150 tornadoes in March, 200 to 300 in April and 250 to 350 in May, all of which are near or above the 30-year historical average.
- For the year, 1,300 to 1,450 tornadoes are foreseen, compared to the historical average of 1,225.
- The bulk of the tornadoes in 2025 are forecasted to focus on the central and southern U.S., they can happen anywhere in the country.
