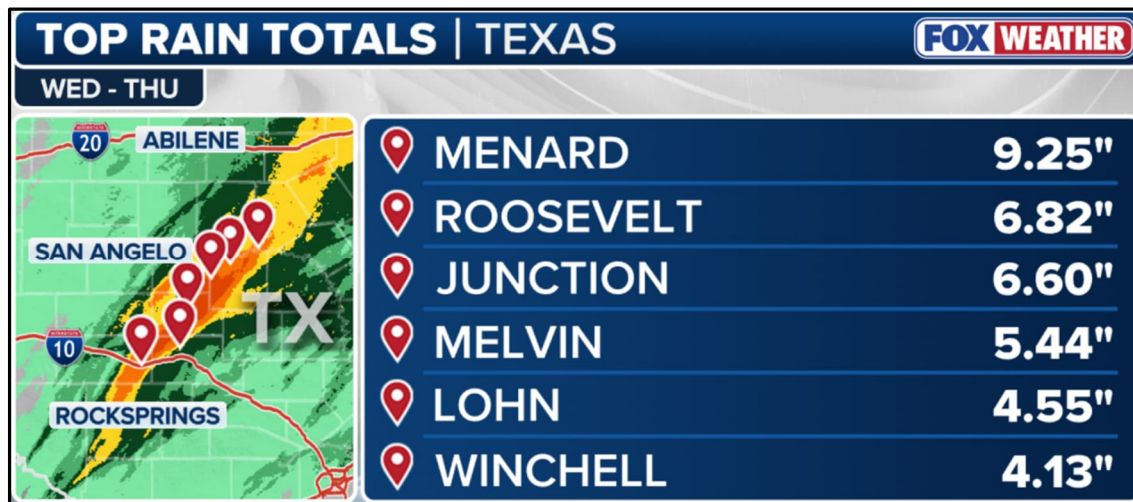
WSP USA INSPECTION SERVICES DISASTER AWARENESS REPORT

November 21, 2025

Flash Flooding Activity

Texas

- A powerful storm system dumped record amounts of rain across parts of Texas Hill Country and North Texas Thursday.
- The National Weather Service office in San Angelo to issue a Flash Flood Emergency early Thursday afternoon for Concho, McCulloch and Menard Counties due to life-threatening flooding stemming from extreme rainfall in the area.
- Menard recorded 9.25 inches of rain from the event and the San Saba River crested at 13.25 feet Thursday afternoon.
- Heavy rain also reached North Texas where Dallas Fort Worth International Airport (DFW) recorded 3.95 inches of rain.
- Kerr County and other parts of Texas Hill Country dealt with 3 inches of rain that fell in the span of a few hours overnight on Thursday.
- Texas Gov. Greg Abbott activated state emergency resources on Wednesday morning before storms developed over the region.
