February 13, 2025

Atmospheric River California

- Most of the California coast is under a flood alert as torrential rain and mountain snow intensified over California Thursday morning.
- Part of yet another atmospheric river storm, bringing a significant risk of flooding and landslides in areas recently affected by devastating wildfires.
- Evacuation warnings and evacuation orders were issued for burn zones in Los Angeles.
- Flash Flood Warnings were issued early Thursday morning for counties around San Francisco.
- Voluntary evacuations were issued near burn scars in Orange County.
- Many areas forecast to see up to 8 inches or more of rain include burn-scar areas in Southern California.
- Areas including Santa Barbara, Los Angeles and Riverside face a Level 3 out of 4 flash flood risk through Friday.
- This system will pack powerful winds with gusts up to 60 mph.
- Scattered power outages are possible across the state through Friday.
