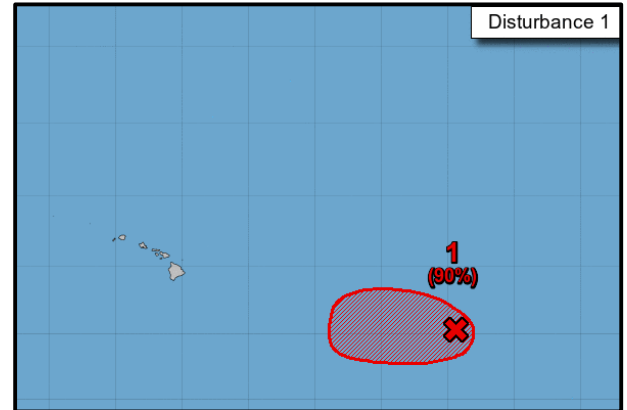

Tropical Activity

Central Pacific – Disturbance #1

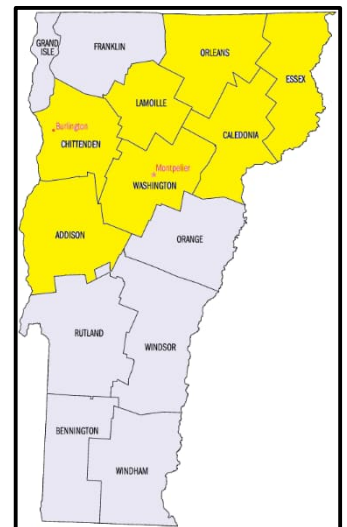
- Located approximately 1300 miles east-southeast of the Hawaiian Islands moving westward at 10-15 mph.
- A tropical depression or tropical storm is likely to develop later today.
- Interests in Hawaii should closely monitor this disturbance, though it remains too early to determine the exact location and magnitude of potential impacts.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (90%)
- Formation chance through 7 days: High (90%)



Declaration Activity

DR 4810 – Vermont

- On August 20, 2024, President Joseph R. Biden, Jr. declared that a major disaster exists in the State of Vermont and ordered Federal assistance to supplement state and local recovery efforts in the areas affected by a severe storm, flooding, landslides, and mudslides from July 9 to July 11, 2024.
- The President's action makes Federal funding available to affected individuals in the counties of Addison, Caledonia, Chittenden, Essex, Lamoille, Orleans, and Washington.
- Flooding on July 10 and 11 devastated many of the same areas that were impacted by last summer's flood, destroying infrastructure, homes, and property.
- Governor Phil Scott declared a State of Emergency for this event on July 10, 2024.
- A combination of flash flooding, river flooding, and severe weather was observed as the remnants of tropical cyclone Beryl interacted with a quasi-stationary front draped across the Northeastern United States.
- The heaviest rainfall fell along an axis from Essex County NY east-northeastward across central into northeastern Vermont.
- Total rainfall amounts were generally between 3-5" within this heavy rain axis, with localized values exceeding 7".
- A couple of the higher rainfall totals included 6.76" in Hinesburg and 7.1" in Walden.
