Tornado Activity

<u>Mississippi</u>

- Weather officials confirmed that 12 tornadoes touched down in Mississippi Sunday.
- The Mississippi Emergency Management Agency said Wednesday that no fatalities were reported to the agency from severe weather in the state May 2 and May 4.
- There has been significant property damage to parts of Mississippi and it's working with county EMA directors to complete damage assessments.



Tornado damage extensive in Jackson, MS neighborhoods.

- Based on initial assessments of the impacted areas, counties estimate that approximately 100 homes were damaged statewide as a result of the severe storms on May 4, 2021.
- However, as of this morning, only two counties had officially submitted preliminary damage reports to the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency:
 - Rankin 4 homes affected
 - Warren 7 homes affected
- The following counties have submitted official preliminary damage reports from the severe weather on May 2, 2021 to the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency:
 - Hinds 24 homes affected
 - Lee 65 homes affected; 2 businesses affected
 - Pontotoc 10 homes affected; 1 business affected
 - Yazoo 76 homes affected; 4 businesses affected

Declaration Activity

Georgia (Public Assistance only)

- President Biden declared a major disaster in Georgia Wednesday in response to two days of destructive and deadly storms back in late-March.
- North Georgia experienced severe weather, including tornadoes, on March 25 and 26, prompting the President to order Federal assistance to supplement local recovery efforts in the affected areas.
- Funding will be available to state, tribal, and local governments, along with some private nonprofit organizations, for emergency work and repair and replacement of facilities damaged by the deadly storms that affected Coweta, Fannin, Gilmer, Heard, Lumpkin, Pickens, Rabun, and White counties.
- Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the state and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.


