
Tropical Activity Atlantic – Hurricane Humberto (CAT 1)

- Currently centered over 400 miles northeast of the Leeward Islands and moving northwest.
- The hurricane is gaining strength and is forecast to become the season's third Category 3+ hurricane this weekend.
- Humberto could be of some threat to Bermuda sometime early to mid-next week but is unlikely to be a direct U.S. threat.



Atlantic - Disturbance 1 (94L)

- A tropical wave currently near Haiti and the Turks and Caicos Islands will continue wringing out showers with locally heavy rain and gusty winds in those areas today.
- This tropical wave brought widespread rainfall of 1 to 4 inches across Puerto Rico, with the heaviest totals being reported across the southern parts of the territory.
- This weekend, when this system is near the Bahamas, it is expected to develop into Tropical Storm Imelda.
- Chances for impacts from winds, rainfall, and storm surge for a portion of the southeast United States coast during the next several days is increasing.
- Formation chance through 48-hour: High (80%); 7 day: High (90%)
