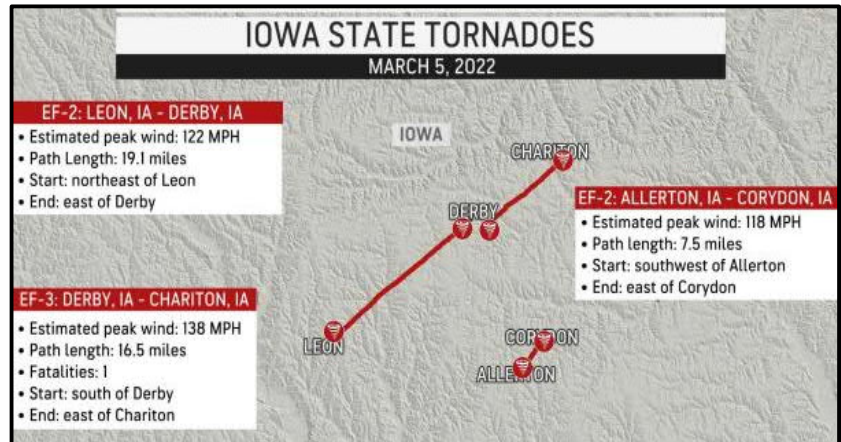

Tornado Activity

Iowa

- Severe weather moved through the Midwest March 5th & 6th.
- As of early Sunday morning, there were a total of 42 preliminary tornado reports, largely sent in from Iowa.
- At least seven fatalities were reported between two Iowa counties after a large and damaging tornado caused significant damage to the towns of Winterset, Iowa, and Patterson, each located to the southwest of Des Moines, making this the deadliest tornado to hit Iowa since 2008, according to reporting from the Des Moines Register.
- Diogenes Ayala, director of the emergency management agency in Madison County, where six of the reported fatalities occurred, estimated that at least 25 to 30 houses had been destroyed by the tornado.
- Iowa Gov. Kim Reynolds issued a disaster proclamation for the area Saturday evening.



Wildfire Activity

Florida

- Evacuation orders are still in place for about 600 homes in the Florida Panhandle as crews battle at least four dangerous wildfires, authorities said.
- The Florida Forest Service said Sunday that nearly 10,000 acres are currently burning in the Panhandle.
- The Bertha Swamp Road Fire, which is the largest of the two wildfires, has burned 8,000 acres and is only about 10% contained, officials said in a news release.
- Governor DeSantis expanded a state of emergency on Saturday to include two more counties impacted by the fires. The governor's decision amends an executive order -- which declared a state of emergency in Bay County -- to include Calhoun and Gulf counties.
- The Bay County fire, which started Friday, is 30% contained, the forest service said in a news release. Around 600 homes have been evacuated, authorities said. The forest service said two homes have been destroyed and 12 more damaged.
- Two other fires are also burning across the Florida panhandle. The Adkins Avenue Fire near Panama City Beach is currently 841 acres and is 35% contained, DeSantis said Sunday.
- Bay County Florida Emergency Services said on its Facebook page Sunday "there is a new fire south of Tram Road and west of Star Ave." The fire is approximately 200 acres and 10% contained, according to the post.
