## Flooding Activity Hawaii

- Hawaii is grappling with the aftermath of catastrophic flooding caused by two consecutive storms that dumped up to 50 inches of rain across parts of the state.
- Over the weekend, a second Kona Low Pressure System caused flash flooding in Honolulu and Maui Counties, leading to rescues, temporary shelter operations, and closures of medical facilities.
- Although evacuation orders have been lifted and conditions are improving, a Flood Watch remains for the Big Island.
- Gov. Green said that the storm has caused around \$1 billion in estimated damages.
- The storm prompted evacuation orders for 5,500 people north of Honolulu and more than 200 people were rescued from the rising waters.
- Joint Preliminary Damage Assessment tentatively scheduled to begin today.
