# Tropical Activity Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- A broad area of low pressure is likely to develop over the southwestern Caribbean Sea during the next day or so.
- A tropical depression is likely to form late this weekend or early next week.
- The system drifts generally northward or northwestward over the central or western Caribbean Sea.
- Locally heavy rains are possible over portions of the adjacent land areas of the western Caribbean.
- Formation change: 48-hour Low (30%); 7-day High (70%)

#### Atlantic - Disturbance 2

- A trough of low pressure located near Puerto Rico is producing a large area of showers and thunderstorms over portions of the Greater Antilles and the adjacent waters of the Atlantic and the northeastern Caribbean.
- Moving west northwestward near the Greater Antilles.
- This system is expected to be absorbed into the low-pressure area over the Caribbean.
- Locally heavy rains are possible during the next several days from the northern Leeward Islands westward across Puerto Rico and Hispaniola to eastern Cuba and the southeastern Bahamas.
- Formation change: 48-hour Low (10%); 7-day Low (10%)

#### Atlantic – Disturbance 3

- A storm-force non-tropical low-pressure area located about 400 miles west of the western Azores.
- Some subtropical development is possible while the low moves generally eastward during the next few days.
- Formation change: 48-hour Low (10%); 7-day Low (10%)

#### Eastern Pacific - Disturbance 1

- Located more than 1000 miles southwest of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula has continued to persist this morning.
- Some further development of this system is possible during the next couple of days while the low moves slowly westward.
- It is expected to cross into the Central Pacific Basin by the end of the week.




#### November 1, 2024

- Late this weekend environmental conditions are expected to become less conducive for development.
- Formation change: 48-hour Medium (40%); 7-day Medium (40%)

### Eastern Pacific - Disturbance 2

- An area of low pressure could form well offshore of southwestern Mexico during the early to middle part of next week.
- Some slow development is possible while the system drifts slowly eastward.
- Formation change: 48-hour Low (0%); 7-day Low (30%)
