

## Tropical Activity Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- The National Hurricane Center (NHC) is watching an area for possible tropical development as the end of the 2023 Atlantic hurricane season nears.
- An area of low pressure is expected to develop along a frontal boundary over the central subtropical Atlantic Ocean in a day or so.
- The non-tropical low is expected to move to the southeast across the central subtropical Atlantic over warmer ocean water during the next few days.



- Environmental conditions could allow the system to gradually acquire tropical or subtropical characteristics.
- The NHC says a subtropical or tropical storm could form late this week or over the weekend as the system turns to the northeast.
- If the storm earns a name, it will become Vince, the second-to-last name on the 2023 Atlantic naming list.
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (20%); 7-day: Medium (50%)
