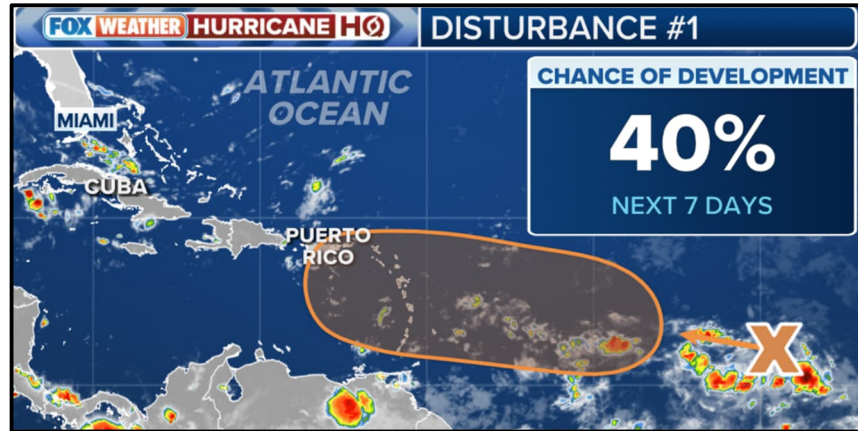

## Tropical Activity

### Atlantic Disturbance #1

- A tropical disturbance well off the coast of western Africa that could develop early next week in the tropical Atlantic.
- Should the disturbance develop, it will track west and potentially impact the northern Caribbean islands sometime next week, according to the NHC.
- It is too soon to know the eventual track and impacts, but those in the northern Caribbean islands should monitor the system.
- "The steering currents over the tropical Atlantic are very light, so it's going to take several days for the disturbance to reach the islands," Hurricane Specialist Bryan Norcross said.
- "On the current schedule, that would happen Monday or Tuesday."
- The NHC has given this disturbance a low chance of development over the next seven days.



## Severe Weather Activity

### Midwest

- For the third time this week, severe weather may hammer parts of Minnesota and Wisconsin.
- The first round came Monday afternoon, knocking out power to more than 100,000 utility customers across Minnesota.
- The next round came early Tuesday morning as the Twin Cities recorded wind gusts as high as 64 mph.
- Thursday's severe thunderstorms are expected across the upper and middle Mississippi Valley to the central Plains.
- The severe storm potential will likely set up across Minnesota, with the Twin Cities right in the crosshairs.
- Damaging wind and hail are the main threats as a line of storms fires up along the front during the afternoon, but a spin-up of a tornado or two cannot be ruled out, the FOX Forecast Center said.
