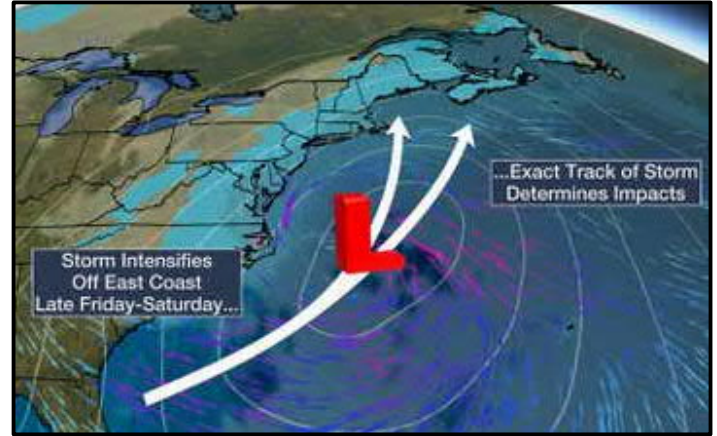

## Winter Storm Outlook

### East Coast

- A strong storm forecast to develop off the East Coast by this weekend will grow into a powerful nor'easter, bringing heavy snow, strong winds and coastal flooding to parts of the Northeast.
- The setup begins Friday with a cold front moving across the Northeast that will haul in a fresh blast of chilly air prior to this storm's potential impact.
- Then, low pressure will strengthen as it tracks near or off the East Coast late Friday through Saturday in response to an upper-level disturbance diving from western Canada to the central and eastern United States.
- It's likely this storm will grow into a "bomb cyclone" – a term meteorologists use for a low-pressure system associated with fronts with a central pressure that plunges at least 24 millibars in 24 hours or less.
- But what's still in doubt is the exact track of this bomb cyclone in relation to the East Coast – an uncertainty that's typical a few days in advance.
- Right now, portions of New England have the highest probability of seeing heavy snow, regardless of whether the storm tracks farther offshore or closer to the coast.
- Areas farther south from around the New York tri-state area to the coastal mid-Atlantic could also see significant snow and wind, especially if the storm tracks closer to the coast, as some forecast model guidance depicts.
