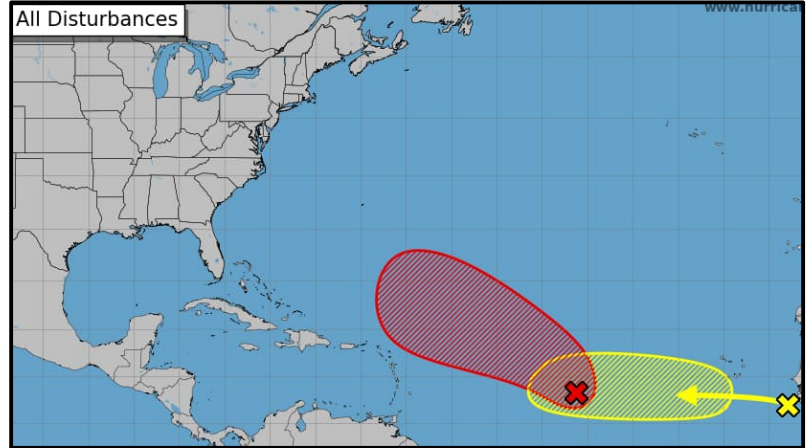

Tropical Activity

Atlantic – Invest 92L

- Located midway between the Windward Islands and the west coast of Africa.
- Gradual development is anticipated.
- The disturbance will likely become a tropical depression or tropical storm by the end of the week as it churns northwestward across the central Atlantic Ocean.
- The next named storm will be called Gabrielle.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: High (90%); 7-day: High (90%)



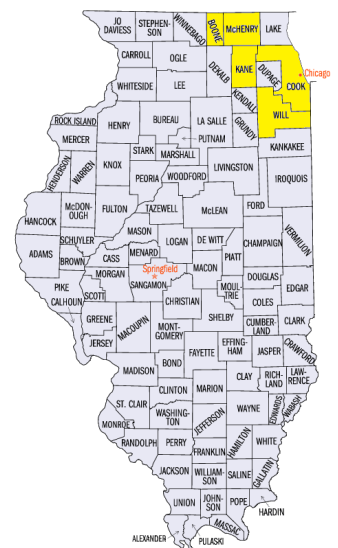
Atlantic – Disturbance 2

- A tropical wave emerging off the west coast of Africa is producing an area of disorganized showers and thunderstorms.
- Some slow development of this system is possible towards the mid to latter part of this week as it moves westward at 15 to 20 mph, moving from the eastern to central portion of the tropical Atlantic.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7 day: Low (20%)

Declaration Request

Illinois (August 16-19 Flooding)

- On September 15, 2025, Governor JB Pritzker issued a state disaster proclamation after severe weather and flooding caused extensive damage across Boone, Cook, Kane, McHenry, and Will Counties from August 16-19, 2025.
- The Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security (IEMA-OHS), in partnership with local government entities and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), conducted joint Preliminary Damage Assessments (PDAs) September 3-5, 2025, that confirmed widespread damages to communities.
- The flooding from this storm system caused moderate to extensive damage to over 5,500 homes within the impacted counties.
- Some of the neighborhoods impacted were still recovering from July flooding, officials said.
