

Tropical Activity Atlantic – Potential Tropical Cyclone

- Tropical Storm Warnings are now in effect for portions of the Leeward Islands as Potential Tropical Cyclone Five, which forecasters say will likely become Tropical Storm Ernesto by Tuesday, continues to barrel toward the Caribbean islands.
- The NHC said the system is likely to become Tropical Storm Ernesto, and additional watches and warnings may also be issued.



- According to the NHC, Potential Tropical Cyclone Five is located over the Central Tropical Atlantic and is moving toward the west near 25 mph.
- The NHC says a west to west-northwest motion is expected with some decrease in forward speed over the next few days.
- Tropical Storm Watches remain in effect for several areas, including the U.S. territories of Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, however some alerts have been upgraded to Tropical Storm Warnings.

Declaration Activity DR-4806 – Florida

- On August 10th, President Joseph R. Biden, Jr. declared that a major disaster exists in the State of Florida and ordered Federal aid to supplement State, tribal, and local recovery efforts in the areas affected by Hurricane Debby beginning on August 1, 2024, and continuing.
- The President's action makes Federal funding available to affected individuals in the counties of Columbia, Dixie, Gilchrist, Hamilton, Lafayette, Levy, Manatee, Sarasota, Suwannee, and Taylor.
- Tropical Storm Debby drenched Florida on Monday August 1st, 2024.
- The slow-moving storm plowed into Florida's Gulf Coast around 7

 a.m. (1100 GMT) on Monday morning as a Category 1 hurricane,
 making landfall near Steinhatchee about 70 miles (115 km) southeast of Tallahassee, the
 National Hurricane Center said.
- The storm carried hurricane-force winds of up to 80 mph (130 kph) when it struck in the Big Bend region where the state's Panhandle meets its main north-south Peninsula but speeds ebbed as Debby pushed over land.
