## Potential Flooding Southeast

- According to the FOX Forecast Center, backto-back storms this week are bringing repeated rounds of rain.
- Starting in West Texas and stretching north and eastward all the way to the Southeast coast, covering North Carolina, Georgia and portions of northern Florida.
- The greatest threat of flash flooding will be from Tuesday night into Wednesday in Tennessee and northern portions of Louisiana, Mississippi and Alabama.
- The first round of heavy rain is breaking out across parts of Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas and Tennessee on Tuesday morning.
- This rain will stall and remain over the same area into Wednesday when rain from the second storm takes over the same areas.
- Parts of Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia and Tennessee expected to see the highest amounts.

## Earthquake Activity California

- A magnitude 4.1 earthquake shook some Northern California communities early Tuesday morning.
- According to the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS), a magnitude 4.1 earthquake was reported about 13 miles west of Petrolia in the Pacific Ocean just after midnight Tuesday at a depth of about 12 miles.
- Shaking was felt by residents in communities such as Eureka and Fortuna. So far there are no reports of damage or injuries.
- On Monday, a pair of back-to-back earthquakes rattled the San Bernardino area in Southern California. Those earthquakes were measured as a magnitude 3.6 and a magnitude 3.0.
