

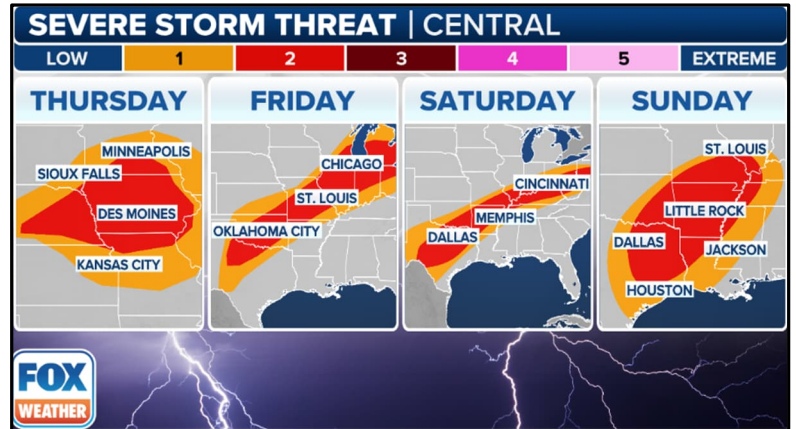

April 16, 2025

Severe Weather Outlook Central U.S.

- An active stretch of severe weather is expected to develop late this week and continue into the Easter weekend, with the most significant threats likely on Friday and over the weekend.
- There's a chance for very isolated thunderstorms over Nebraska and Kansas on Wednesday evening. By Thursday morning, storms could produce large hail in parts of Nebraska, northern Missouri and Iowa.
- The most significant severe weather threat is expected to develop on Friday, covering an area stretching from the southern Plains all the way into the Great Lakes region.
- Numerous thunderstorms are expected to develop Friday afternoon and evening, impacting those celebrating Good Friday. The threats include damaging winds, large hail and potentially tornadoes.



Disaster Declaration Request Arkansas (Appeal)

- The State of Arkansas received a formal denial from the federal government for Individual Assistance (IA) funding through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in response to the severe storms and tornadoes that impacted the state on March 14.
- Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders announced that her administration is actively working with the Arkansas Division of Emergency Management (ADEM) to appeal the federal government's decision.
- "This denial does not reflect the full extent of the hardship Arkansans are facing," Governor Sanders said. "We are committed to fighting for the resources our communities need to recover and rebuild."
- Meanwhile, joint local, state, and federal teams are conducting damage assessments related to a second round of severe storms and flooding that began on April 2 and continue to affect parts of the state.
- These assessments are expected to last through the end of April. Once complete, the State will compile the findings and submit a request to the White House for a Major Disaster Declaration.
