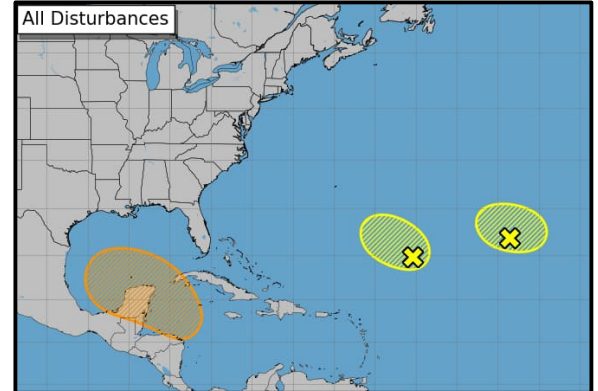

Tropical Activity

Atlantic - Disturbance 1

- Located more than a thousand miles southwest of the Azores.
- Any additional development of this system is expected to be slow to occur while it meanders over the central sub-tropical Atlantic during the next couple of days.
- Formation chance: 48-hour – Low (20%); 7-day – Low (20%)



Atlantic – Disturbance 2

- Located 650 miles northeast of the northern Leeward Islands.
- Some development of this system is possible over the next several days.
- Formation chance: 48-hour – Low (20%); 7-day – Low (20%)

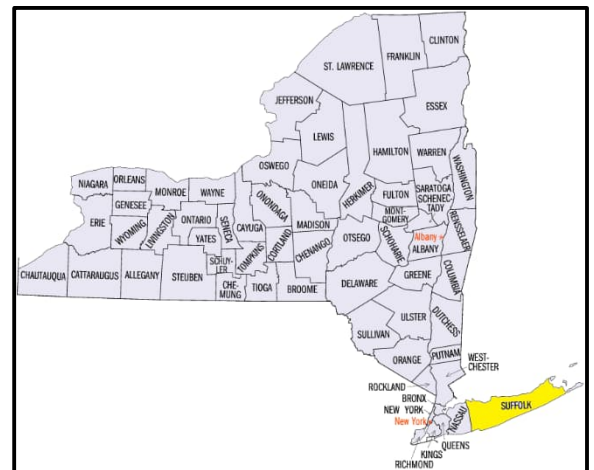
Gulf of Mexico – Disturbance 3

- Gradual development of this system is possible.
- A tropical depression could form as the system moves slowly to the north or northwest over the northwestern Caribbean Sea and into the southern Gulf of Mexico through the end of next week.
- Formation chance: 48-hour – Low (near 0%); 7-day – Medium (40%)

Disaster Declaration Request

New York

- On September 18th, Governor Kathy Hochul requested a Major Disaster Declaration from President Biden to support the ongoing recovery in Suffolk County impacted by record rainfall and widespread flash flooding that resulted in substantial damage on August 18-19, 2024.
- The storm left a trail of destruction that led to multiple swift water rescues, severely damaged roads, major road closures, sinkholes, dam failure and flooded residences and buildings that required evacuations.
- The flooding was so significant that the National Weather Service declared the first-ever flash flood emergency for Suffolk County. This event was a 1-in-1,000-year rain event for the impacted area.
- Over 2,000 residents and business owners experienced flood damage in some capacity.
