

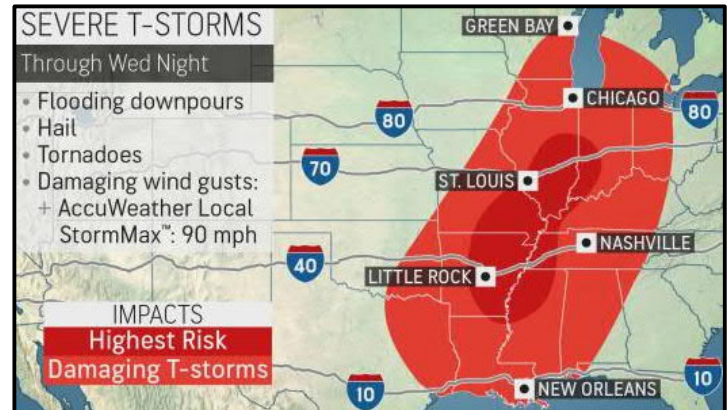

April 13, 2022

Severe Weather Outlook

- Close to 100 million Americans will be at risk for all forms of severe weather that includes tornadoes on Wednesday and Wednesday night as a dangerous severe weather threat persists, AccuWeather meteorologists warn.
- The storms will hit some of the same areas that have been hammered by tornadoes and high winds on a weekly basis over the past month.
- The midweek severe weather threat includes major cities such as New Orleans, Nashville and Little Rock, Arkansas, to the south and St. Louis, Chicago and Indianapolis to the north.
- The risk of storms will extend as far to the north as part of the Lower Peninsula of Michigan and to near Green Bay, Wisconsin.
- "Tornadoes will remain a high concern on Wednesday and Wednesday evening with the continued potential for tornadoes to be strong and on the ground for an extended period of time," AccuWeather Meteorologist Andrew Johnson-Levine said.
- AccuWeather meteorologists have outlined an area from central Arkansas to central Illinois and southwestern Indiana where the greatest potential for multiple strong and long-lived tornadoes is most likely.
- The zone on Wednesday is roughly the same area that was devastated by a tornado outbreak on Dec. 10-11, 2021.



Tornado Activity

- Tuesday was the second-consecutive night of powerful, tornado-producing storms across the Midwest and the Missouri Valley.
- National Weather Service meteorologists say up to 10 tornadoes were reported across northern Iowa Tuesday. Early reports indicate extensive property in the Humboldt County area.
- At least 23 people are injured after a tornado ripped through part of central Texas and caused significant damage.
- The tornado struck Salado, Texas, in Bell County, around 50 miles northeast of Austin.
- Bell County Judge David Blackburn said that 12 of those injured were transported to hospitals and one person was critically injured, but that he believed everyone was accounted for.
- Many homes were damaged or destroyed, according to police in Salado.
- The same storm system moved eastward and dropped tornadoes in northwest Louisiana, including Bossier City and portions of southeast Shreveport.
- There have been reports of people trapped inside their mobile home, according to meteorologist Craig Ceecee. Another tornado reportedly touched down around Hosston, Louisiana.
