Flash Flooding Pacific Northwest

- Washington was slammed with major flooding this week after days of relentless rain from a deadly Pineapple Express atmospheric river storm pounded the Pacific Northwest and sent rivers overflowing their banks.
- Neighborhoods, roads and highways from the Pacific coast to the foothills of the Cascades were covered with floodwaters, and at least two people in Oregon were killed in the flooding.



- Several counties across the region are under a Flood Warning as some rivers near populated areas in the foothills of western Washington climb to "major" flood stage.
- As much as 3-7 inches of precipitation has fallen in the Cascade and Olympic mountains, with localized amounts between 8 and 10 inches in the Cascade foothills northeast of Seattle.
- The U.S. Coast Guard rescued five people from flooded areas on Tuesday.
- Rain will fall over most of the passes into Wednesday evening. But the NWS warns that the flood threat will continue into Thursday.
