Tropical Activity

<u> Atlantic – Disturbance 1</u>


- Located between west Africa and the Windward Islands moving WNW at 15 to 20 mph.
- Additional strengthening forecast, possible development to a hurricane later this week.
- Formation chance 48-hour: High (near 100%); 7-day: High (near 100%)

Atlantic – Disturbance 2

- Located near the coast of west Africa moving WNW at 10 to 15 mph.
- A tropical depression is likely to form later this week.
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (30%); 7-day: High (70%)

Atlantic – Disturbance 3

- Located a few hundred miles N of the Azores moving SE.
- Formation chance 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (20%)



Hurricane Idalia

<u>Georgia</u>

- Following the days of storm damage from Hurricane Idalia ravaging parts of Florida and Georgia, Gov. Brian Kemp traveled south to assess the damage to Georgia communities in the storm's path.
- The governor was in Valdosta Friday afternoon surveying damage from the storm.
- On Wednesday, the storm flooded streets, blew down thousands of trees, and pushed hundreds of those trees onto homes and other structures, even blocking roads.
- Damage statewide from the hurricane-turned-tropical storm is estimated to be around \$35 million.

- One death in Valdosta was attributed to the storm. •
