## Severe Weather Outlook

#### <u>West</u>

- A powerful atmospheric river is slamming into Northern California and is expected to persist for days.
- The storm first began to hit the Seattle area Tuesday night, killing at least one person and injuring two others as 50-75 mph winds toppled trees across the region.
- The worst is yet to come for Northern California in the bullseye of this atmospheric river.

- Through Saturday, some areas could see 3-5 inches of rain daily, with even higher amounts possible in the mountains.
- This has prompted the Weather Prediction Center to issue a rare "extreme" flash flood risk area for northern California for Thursday.
- Moderate rain will continue for several days, leading to potential flooding on roads, small streams and even larger rivers later in the week.
- Measurements showed the storm dropped 66 millibars in pressure in 24 hours, eventually becoming a storm with a central pressure of 943 millibars on par with a major Category 4 hurricane.
- A High Wind Warning was issued for the Seattle and Everett areas on Tuesday night.
- An estimated more than 700,000 people had lost power across Western Washington as of early Wednesday morning, according to PowerOutage.US.
- Over 100,000 of them were in the city of Seattle.
- The winds were expected to abate by early Wednesday morning.


