

Winter Weather Outlook

- A powerful winter storm packing heavy snow, rain and even severe weather is threatening Thanksgiving travel plans for millions as people across the U.S.
- The coast-to-coast storm began its journey over the weekend when it slammed into the West Coast with torrential rain and heavy mountain snow.
- The storm then pushed off to the east and moved into the Rockies, where it dumped snow in Utah and Colorado.



- Winter weather alerts remain in effect across the region, with cities like Colorado Springs and Denver under Winter Weather Advisories.
- By Thanksgiving Day, the system will move into the Midwest and Ohio Valley and then into the Northeast, threatening the region with more winter weather.
- The FOX Forecast Center said rain is expected in the Midwest on Wednesday but remains focused on the threat of snow from Illinois to Ohio.
- The heaviest snow is expected across the mountainous areas of the Catskills, Poconos, Adirondacks and Green and White Mountains.
- To the south of the snow, steady rain will be falling across the mid-Atlantic and southern New England. Also be keeping its eye on the Southeast, where there is the potential for severe weather.
- The main threat from storms that develop will be damaging wind gusts, but there is also the possibility of some tornadoes.


