WSP USA INSPECTION SERVICES DISASTER AWARENESS REPORT

February 14, 2025

Severe Weather Southeast

- A powerful storm system will bring a mix of snow, rain and severe weather to the central and eastern U.S. this weekend.
- Dangerous storms are likely to erupt across the Southeast throughout the day and night on Saturday.
- Scattered to numerous damaging wind gusts and a few tornadoes are the primary threats.
- The FOX Forecast Center said some of these tornadoes could be strong (EF-2+ or stronger), especially in areas that see more sun on Saturday afternoon.
- A Level 3 out of 5 severe storm risk has been issued by the National Weather Service's Storm Prediction Center.
- Approximately 5.3 million people are affected by the storm risk in cities including Memphis, Tennessee; Shreveport and Bossier City in Louisiana; Jackson, Mississippi; and Tuscaloosa, Alabama.
- On Saturday into Saturday night, widespread and repeated rounds of heavy rainfall are expected in the Southeast into the Ohio Valley.
- Rainfall amounts of 3-5 inches or higher are possible, particularly across portions of Tennessee, Kentucky, southern Ohio, southern West Virginia and western Virginia.
- With rain rates of 1 inch or more per hour falling on already saturated soil across the region, a rare high risk of flash flooding (Level 4) could be issued.
- Flood Watches have been issued that extend over 900 miles from Arkansas to Pennsylvania.
