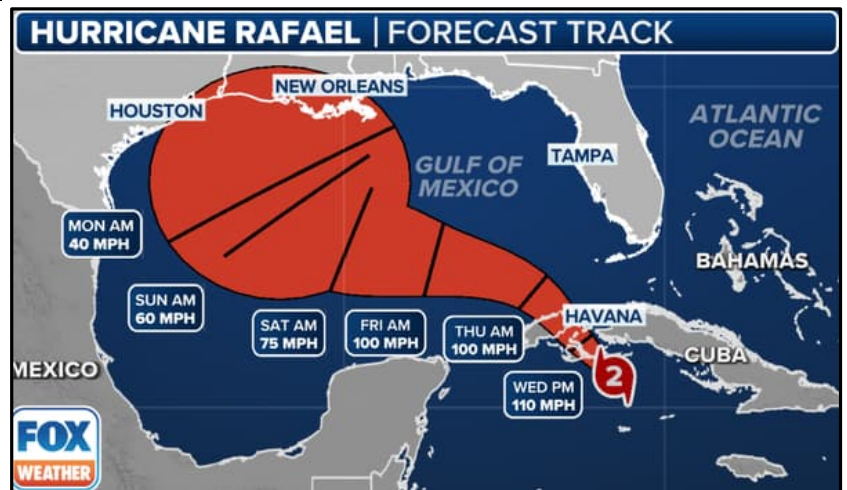

November 6, 2024

Tropical Activity

Atlantic –Hurricane Rafael (Cat 2)

- Rafael continues to intensify, strengthening into a Category 2 hurricane early Wednesday morning.
- Forecasters said the late-season storm could approach major hurricane strength when it makes landfall in Cuba.
- Millions of people along the U.S. Gulf Coast from Texas to Florida are keeping their eyes on the hurricane.
- Rafael is expected to briefly weaken while spinning across western Cuba.
- It is forecast to remain at hurricane strength (74 mph or greater) as it emerges into the Gulf of Mexico.
- Tropical storm conditions are expected in parts of west-central Cuba and the lower and middle Florida Keys through Wednesday night.
- In the lower and middle Florida Keys, rainfall totals of 1-3 inches are expected.
- As of the latest advisory from the NHC, Rafael is less than 100 miles east-southeast of the Isle of Youth and moving northwest at 14 mph.
- Rafael has maximum sustained winds of 100 mph.
- The official forecast calls for the hurricane to intensify with winds topping out at 110 mph, making it a high-end Category 2 hurricane.
- A Tropical Storm Warning remains in effect for the lower and middle Florida Keys from Key West to the Channel 5 Bridge, as well as for the Dry Tortugas.
- Rafael is expected to continue moving northwest for the next day or two, followed by a gradual turn toward the west-northwest in the Gulf of Mexico.
- Expected to move over western Cuba later Wednesday and move into the southeastern Gulf of Mexico on Wednesday night.
