

Tropical Activity <u>Central Pacific – Tropical Storm Kiko</u>


- Kiko was downgraded from a hurricane to a tropical storm late Monday night with maximum sustained winds of 60 mph.
- Currently located less than 400 miles to the northeast of Hilo, Hawaii, and about 375 miles east of Honolulu.
- Moving off to the west-northwest at 14 mph, and that motion is expected to continue for the next few days while passing to the north of the main Hawaiian Islands.



 There are currently no coastal or flood-related watches or warnings active across any of the Hawaiian Islands.

Coastal Flooding Southeast

- A sprawling, stationary front has parked itself just off the Eastern Seaboard, which will bring days of dry conditions for most of the East Coast.
- However, this same weather pattern will bring a flood threat to low-lying coastal communities and days of dangerous beach conditions.
- An area of strong high pressure over New England will bring strong winds from the northeast pushing water onto and over East Coast beaches.
- Charleston, South Carolina's harbor will likely see the worst impacts.
- The NWS has issued Coastal Flood Advisories for minor and moderate flooding from northern Florida through coastal North Carolina lasting into Wednesday morning.
