## Tropical Activity

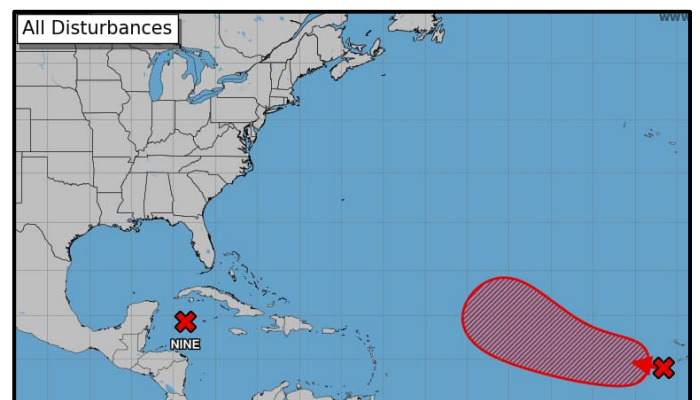
### Atlantic – Potential Tropical Cyclone Nine

- Hurricane Watches have been issued for parts of Florida, including Tampa, as the U.S. Gulf Coast prepares for significant impacts from Potential Tropical Cyclone Nine, which will likely become major Hurricane Helene in the coming days.
- The NHC said Potential Tropical Cyclone Nine is expected to intensify to near-hurricane strength when it reaches the far northwestern Caribbean Sea on Wednesday and will likely intensify into a major hurricane (Category 3 or higher) as it approaches the northeastern Gulf Coast on Thursday.
- "The potential for life-threatening storm surge and damaging hurricane-force winds along the coast of the Florida Panhandle and the Florida west coast is increasing," the NHC warned. "Residents should ensure they have their hurricane plan in place, and also follow advice given by local officials."
- NHC Deputy Director Jamie Rhome told FOX Weather on Monday that over the past 24 hours, the computer forecast models have started to agree on a Florida landfall.
- Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis issued an executive order Monday that declared a state of emergency for 41 of the state's 67 counties to help agencies prepare for the incoming storm.
- Evacuations are expected along Florida's Gulf Coast, including Taylor County in the Big Bend region.
- As of the latest advisory from the NHC, Potential Tropical Cyclone Nine is located about 150 miles west of Grand Cayman and 200 miles south-southeast of the western tip of Cuba with maximum sustained winds of 35 mph, moving to the northwest at 9 mph.



### Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- A tropical wave located near the Cabo Verde Islands has become more concentrated since yesterday.
- A tropical depression is likely to form during the middle to latter part of this week while it moves westward to west-northwestward across the eastern and central tropical Atlantic.
- Formation chance: 48-hour – Medium (40%); 7-day – High (80%)
