

Tropical Activity Atlantic – Tropical Storm Lisa

- Lisa made landfall along the coast of Belize
 Wednesday as a Category 1 tropical cyclone with
 maximum sustained winds of 85 mph and was
 moving west at 12 mph.
- Hurricane force winds extended outward to 15 miles from the center of Lisa.
- A hurricane warning was in effect for the entire coast of Belize and from Chetumal to Puerto Costa Maya, Mexico Wednesday.



Atlantic – Hurricane Martin

- As of 5 a.m. EDT on Thursday, Martin was located 805 miles to the west-northwest of the Azores, an island chain located west of Portugal, and was moving northeastward at 46 mph with sustained winds of 85 mph.
- The system is gradually intensifying over the central north Atlantic and is expected to threaten shipping lanes.
- Martin will not have any immediate impacts to land and will instead take a meandering path across the northern Atlantic in the coming days.

<u> Atlantic – Disturbance 1</u>

- Disorganized showers and thunderstorms are associated with a weak non-tropical area of low pressure located a few hundred miles east of Bermuda.
- Environmental conditions are expected to be marginally conducive for slow subtropical or tropical development of this system during the next few days as it moves slowly southward today and then turns westward by the weekend.
- The disturbance is expected to merge with a larger system developing to its southwest by the end of the weekend and further development is not anticipated at that time.
- Formation chance through 48 hours...low...10 percent.
- Formation chance through 5 days...low...10 percent.

Atlantic – Disturbance 2

- A large non-tropical low-pressure system is expected to develop this weekend over the northeastern Caribbean sea and southwestern Atlantic.
- The system is expected to initially be very broad and disorganized, but environmental conditions could support gradual subtropical or tropical development beginning early next week while it moves generally northward or northwestward.
- Formation chance through 48 hours...low...near 0 percent.
- Formation chance through 5 days...low...30 percent.
