
DALLY DART WSP USA INSPECTION SERVICES DISASTER AWARENESS REPORT

May 30, 2023

Severe Weather Outlook

- Storms on Monday were largely concentrated between eastern Colorado and South Dakota, bringing roughly 2 dozen reports of severe hail and damaging winds.
- A separate area of storms was located well to the south, bringing strong wind gusts and heavy rain to South Texas.
- The main risk area for feisty storms to develop on Tuesday will center along a corridor that extends from the Texas



Panhandle northward to Nebraska, and northeastward into most of Minnesota and far western Wisconsin.

- The strongest storms can produce heavy rain, hail and damaging wind gusts ranging from 60–70 mph with an AccuWeather Local StormMax[™] of 90 mph.
- Storms are likely to form over two separate areas, the first of which being centered in the Upper Midwest. These storms are likely to bring primarily heavy rain and large hail, though some gusty winds can't be ruled out either, in cities such as Minneapolis, St. Cloud and Duluth, Minnesota.
- Meanwhile, additional storms are set to develop east of the Front Range, before sliding across the High Plains during the evening and overnight North Platte, Nebraska, Garden City, Kansas, and Amarillo, Texas, may all be threatened by these storms.
- In this region, the strongest storms can produce heavy rain, hail and damaging wind gusts ranging from 60–70 mph with an AccuWeather Local StormMax[™] of 90 mph. An isolated tornado or two could also spin up across the Plains on Tuesday.

Typhoon Mawar

CNMI

- The CNMI has immediately kicked into full gear its recovery efforts following the glancing blow from Typhoon Mawar, with representatives of the local government and federal partners now on Rota to provide post-typhoon aid.
- Gov. Arnold I. Palacios, Lt. Gov. David M. Apatang, representatives from the CNMI Homeland Security and Emergency Management agency, and Rota lawmakers flew to Rota over the weekend to inspect the damage wrought by Typhoon Mawar and what other resources are needed in terms of recovery.
- Fortunately, Rota did not sustain major damage to critical infrastructure.
- The CUC Power crew has restored power service to an estimated total of 744 or approximately 79% of CUC customers.
- Water service is online for the island of Rota, but a "boil water" notice remains in effect for the island of Rota.
- All 3 airports are operational.
