Tropical Activity Atlantic – Tropical Storm Bill


- The second named storm of the 2021 Atlantic hurricane season has formed several hundred miles off the coast of Virginia and North Carolina on Monday night.
- Tropical Storm Bill was located about 240 miles southeast of Nantucket, Massachusetts, with maximum sustained winds of 50 mph at 5 a.m. EDT Tuesday, according to the National Hurricane Center (NHC). It was moving to the northeast at a forward speed of 31 mph.



- Even though this storm is not a threat to the United States, it will churn up seas offshore, which would be a concern for shipping and fishing interests.
- As this small system passes just to the east of New England, it is possible that a brief period of rough surf may occur in eastern Massachusetts, Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard Tuesday.

Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- Located over the Bay of Campeche.
- Should begin to move N by midweek.
- Tropical depression likely to form late in the week.
- Tropical moisture is predicted to arrive in parts of the southern United States that have been dealing with torrential rain and flooding since May, potentially making matters much worse for hard-hit communities.
- AccuWeather meteorologists have given the disturbance in the Gulf a high risk of development.



- The next name on the list of tropical storms for the 2021 Atlantic hurricane season is Claudette.
- Formation chance through 48 hours...low...20%
- Formation chance through 5 days...high...70%

Atlantic - Disturbance 2

- Several hundred miles S of Cabo Verde Islands.
- Any development should be slow to occur during the next few days.
- Formation chance through 48 hours...low...10%
- Formation chance through 5 days...low...10%
