

Severe Weather Outlook

- After more than a dozen states were targeted by severe weather this past week, some of the same areas will be threatened by thunderstorms once again during the first week of April.
- A dip in the jet stream across the center of the country, which started late last weekend, allowed an early week storm to travel from the Northwest states to the southern Plains, sparking some stronger thunderstorms on Sunday.



- As the storm progresses east, the area of possible severe weather will become more widespread.
- "Severe thunderstorms are expected to erupt across Eastern Texas and reach into the Mississippi River Valley on Monday, including in larger metropolitan areas such as Dallas and San Antonio that could all be at risk," said AccuWeather Meteorologist Andrew Kienzle.

Tornado Activity (March 29-31, 2022)

- From a tornado that wiped out homes in northwest Arkansas to another that killed two people in Florida Panhandle, last week's severe weather outbreak across the South left a trail of destruction in its wake.
- In all, there were 225 reports of tornadoes across more than a dozen states from Tuesday to Thursday, according to the National Weather Service. That number may set a record for the month.
- One of the highest numbers so far was 12 in Alabama, where the tiny town of Faunsdale was picking up the pieces. The community, located about 75 miles west of Montgomery, has less than 100 residents.
- Thirteen tornadoes so far have been confirmed in Mississippi. Six people were injured, according to an update Friday from the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency.
- Damage was reported in 32 counties, including more than 200 homes and dozens of businesses and farms.
- In Louisiana, a tornado hit one town that had experienced a tornado just a week earlier. Neither caused major widespread damage. At least seven other tornadoes were confirmed in the state during last week's outbreak.
