

Atmospheric River California

- The second in a trio of atmospheric river storms blasted Northern California on Tuesday.
- Heavy rain, damaging wind gusts, feet of mountain snow, and even severe thunderstorms, leaving damage and an injury in the San Francisco area.
- This second event comes on the heels of a "Pineapple Express" atmospheric river event.



- The bull's-eye has been in far northern California across Butte and Shasta counties, where over 13 inches and 15 inches of rain, respectively. An additional 3-8 inches of rain is expected in these areas.
- In Siskiyous County, California, near the Oregon border, a neighborhood in Montague was evacuated due to flooding, according to the sheriff's office.
- Napa Valley, several landslides were reported on Tuesday evening, as the rain led to unsafe terrain.
- On Wednesday, the atmospheric river will weaken as it moves toward Southern California.
- In Southern California, minor impacts, such as road flooding and minor creek overflows can be expected.
