

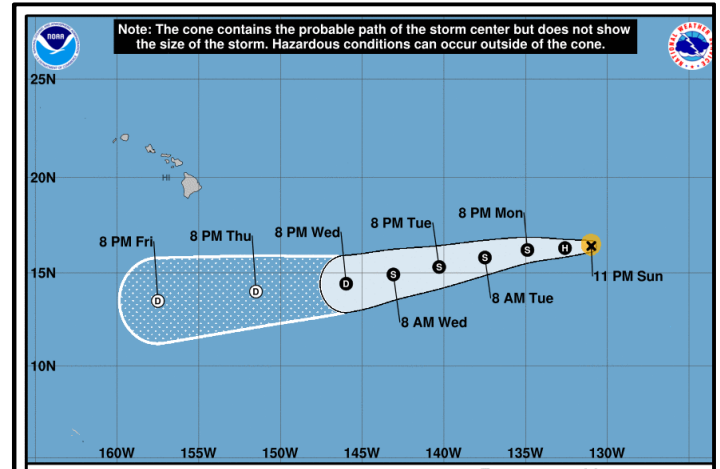

WSP USA INSPECTION SERVICES DISASTER AWARENESS REPORT

July 19, 2021

Tropical Activity – Central Pacific Hurricane Felicia (Cat 2)

- 1,440 miles WSW of the southern tip of Baja California; 1,500 miles E of Big Island of Hawaii
 - Moving W at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 100 mph
- Additional weakening is expected during the next several days
- Hurricane-force winds extend 10 miles; tropical-storm-force winds extend 45 miles



Wildfire Activity

- There are currently 80 large wildfires raging in 13 states across the US, burning more than 1.1 million acres, mostly in western states, according to the National Interagency Fire Center (NIFC). Montana has reported the most large wildfires with 18, and Idaho is close behind with 17, the NIFC said.

Oregon – Bootleg Fire

- The Bootleg fire in southern Oregon has been burning since early July and now covers a little more than 300,000 acres — the size of New York City.
- According to InciWeb, the National Fire Information Center's website, the fire was only 25% contained as of late Sunday evening. Gusty winds over the weekend, along with an ongoing severe drought, made it difficult for crews to make much headway in controlling the blaze.
- Meteorologists predicted critically dangerous fire weather through at least Monday with lightning possible in both California and southern Oregon.
- Thousands were ordered to evacuate, including some 2,000 who live in rugged terrain among lakes and wildlife refuges near the fire, which has burned at least 67 homes and 100 outbuildings.
