

Flash Flooding Threat

Southern Plains

- The threat of flooding continues to grow for portions of Texas in the southern Plains.
- Heavy rain and severe weather started on Tuesday in Texas and is likely to last through at least the rest of the work-week.
- NOAA's Weather Prediction Center (WPC) has a flash flood risk in Central Texas, including Austin, Waco and College Station.
- The flood threat will gradually shift to the east as the week continues, putting the Ark-La-Tex region at risk on Thursday.
- Severe weather is also possible in Texas on Wednesday. Main threats from storms that develop on Wednesday will be damaging wind gusts and hail.




Eastern Pacific Tropical Activity

Tropical Storm Cosme

- Located more than 500 miles southwest of the southern tip of Mexico's Baja California Peninsula.
- The NHC expects Cosme to completely dissipate by late Thursday or Friday, with no impacts to land.

Disturbance 1

- Disorganized showers and thunderstorms located several hundred miles south of the Gulf of Tehuantepec.
- A tropical depression is likely to form over the weekend while it moves generally west-northwestward just offshore the southwestern coast of Mexico.
- Formation chance through 48 hours Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 7 days - High (90%)



Disturbance 2

- Area of low pressure is forecast to develop late this weekend or early next week near the coast of Central America.
- Moving west northwestward near the coasts of Central America and southern Mexico.
- Formation chance through 48 hours Low (0%)
- Formation chance through 7 days - Low (20%)
