

Tornado Activity

<u>Alabama</u>

- At least one person was killed and three were in critical condition after a tornado touched down Thursday afternoon in western Alabama.
- The first confirmed tornado touched down around 2 p.m. Thursday near Sawyerville, in Hale County, according to the National Weather Service's Birmingham office.
- Hale County EMA director Russell Weeden said there were reports of injuries and entrapments from "the river area all the way to County Road 50" in the Sawyerville area. There were also



reports of severely damaged homes along Highway 14 at Coleman Road, which has led road closures in that area.

- A tornado was also confirmed near Duncanville in Tuscaloosa County, according to the NWS.
- The severe weather was spawned on the warm side of Winter Storm Landon.

Winter Storm Landon

- Winter Storm Landon pivoted into the Northeast on Friday, but with many roads untreated and frozen, travel concerns were still happening all the way back into Texas.
- The Weather Channel has confirmed three deaths from the storm system.
- More than 300,000 homes and businesses were without power from Texas to New York Friday morning, according to PowerOutage.us.
- The states with the most outages include Tennessee (more than 130,000 outages), Ohio (85,000) and New York (40,000).
- By Friday morning close to 3,000 flights have been canceled within, into or out of the U.S for the third straight day in a row as a winter storm continues to snarl air travel, according to FlightAware.com.
- Texas Gov. Greg Abbott issued a disaster declaration for 17 counties Thursday evening, saying, "This ice storm poses an imminent threat of severe property damage, injury, or loss of life," as temperatures plunged into the low 20s across a large portion of the state and various forms of frozen precipitation accumulated.
- With 10,000 linemen already on the ground, an additional 2,000 are on their way from other states, Gov. Greg Abbott said.
- Power outages have especially been a concern in Texas, where millions of people were left without electricity a year ago during one of the worst cold spells and largest snowfalls in state history.
