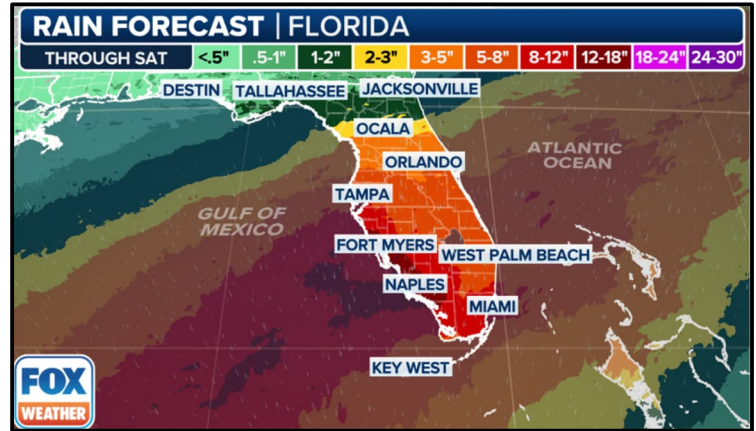

Flood Risk

Florida

- A deluge of tropical moisture is forecast to bombard Florida this week, possibly dropping a foot of rain in some cities and leading to potential flooding across the state.
- This week's tropical downpours are being fueled by high- and low-pressure areas working together to funnel moisture over Florida.
- "We have this area of low pressure back towards Mexico. We also have this area of high pressure over the Atlantic, the two of which are pretty much going to be stationary through the course of this week, but it also is going to act as a funnel as tropical moisture moves its way off towards the north heading into the Gulf of Mexico," FOX Weather Meteorologist Kiyana Lewis said.
- According to the FOX Forecast Center, the highest rain totals will happen between Wednesday and Friday this week, bringing the potential for flooding as that rain adds up.
- By Saturday, some areas in Southwest Florida, including Fort Myers and Naples, could see more than a foot of rain.
- For areas including Miami and Fort Lauderdale, the rain event has already started and both cities could see between 8 and 12 inches of rain throughout the week.
- Orlando is poised to get 3-5 inches, with Thursday being the day with the highest rain totals. For North Florida, 1-2 inches is likely from Jacksonville to St. Augustine.
