Declaration Request Florida

- People recovering from last week's tornadoes in the lona-McGregor neighborhood hope more help is on the way as they continue their clean-up efforts.
- Governor Ron DeSantis declared the State of Emergency for Charlotte and Lee Counties last week, but the Florida Division of Emergency Management said preliminary damage assessments were requested to determine if there was a need for federal aid.
- After looking at the damage assessments, Governor DeSantis requested those federal funds Monday.
- In Lee County, the most recent damage assessment says the 74 homes were completely destroyed during the storm, and 61 homes had major damage. Another 58 homes suffered minor damage.
- In Charlotte County, a confirmed an EF1 tornado touched down in the Gasparilla Mobile Estates, leaving 21 homes uninhabitable and creating structural damage to another 18 homes.
