Eastern Pacific Tropical Activity


Tropical Storm Barbara

- Tropical Storm Barbara is off Mexico's southern coast and is expected to become the Eastern Pacific's first hurricane on Monday.
- The National Hurricane Center (NHC) said Barbara has maximum sustained winds of 70 mph.
- Moving off to the west-northwest at 12 mph and currently located about 185 miles southwest of Manzanillo, Mexico.
- Barbara is expected to continue to move off to the west-northwest over the next few days before making a turn to the west at a slower speed on Tuesday.
- Rainfall totals of 2-4 inches, with locally higher amounts, are forecast for the Mexican states of Guerrero, Michoacan, Colima and Jalisco through Monday.



Tropical Storm Cosme

- Tropical Depression Three-E has strengthened into Tropical Storm Cosme in the Eastern Pacific.
- Forecasted to intensify to near-hurricane strength this week.
- NHC said the maximum sustained winds have reached 50 mph.
- Located 630 miles south-southwest of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico.
- Slowing in forward speed is expected Monday with a turn to the northeast and an increase in forward speed is forecast by late Tuesday through Wednesday.

Severe Weather Activity

Texas

- Powerful thunderstorms packing hurricane-force wind gusts and large hail swept across portions of Texas and Oklahoma on Sunday.
- The storms caused significant damage in areas like Fannin County and flooding issues in Dallas County.
- Power was out for tens of thousands of utility customers but as of 3:30 a.m., Oncor reports 58,000 customers are without power.
- 100-mph wind gust, which is as strong as a Category 2 hurricane, was reported in the community of Goree in Texas.
- 90-mph wind gust was reported in Lakeview, Texas, and numerous wind gusts between 80-90 mph were also reported.
- Hail in Claude Texas was reported as 4.25-inches along with several reports of hail between 2.5 and 2.75 inches across portions of central and North Texas.
