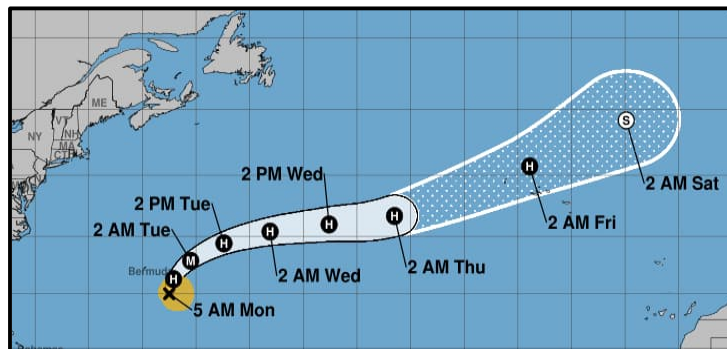

Tropical Activity

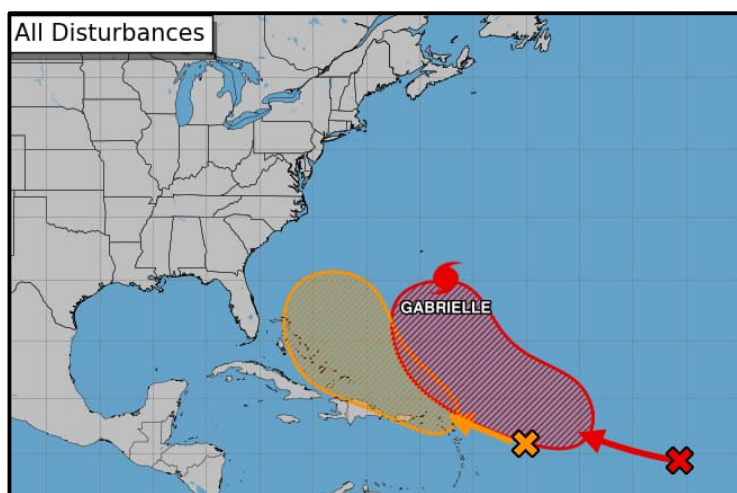
Atlantic – Hurricane Gabrielle (CAT 1)

- Hurricane Gabrielle is now expected to become a major Category 3 hurricane with maximum sustained winds of 120 mph as rapidly as Monday night, according to a National Hurricane Center forecast. However, it is expected to weaken quickly afterward as it hits drier air and wind shear, forecasters said.
- On the forecast track, the center of Hurricane Gabrielle is expected to pass east of Bermuda on Monday evening. Maximum sustained winds as of 5 a.m. ET are 90 mph, the NHC said.
- Gabrielle's tropical-storm-force winds extended 140 miles from the center on Sunday. Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 25 miles.
- A rip current statement is in effect for the east coast of Florida down to West Palm Beach until Wednesday.



Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- Shower and thunderstorm activity associated with a tropical wave located about midway between the Lesser Antilles and the Cabo Verde Islands has increased since yesterday.
- Environmental conditions are forecast to become more favorable for development by tomorrow, and a tropical depression is likely to form by the middle to latter part of this week while the system moves west northwestward.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (20%); 7-day: High (70%)



Atlantic – Disturbance 2

- A tropical wave located about 400 miles east of the Leeward Islands continue to produce disorganized showers and thunderstorms.
- Environmental conditions appear marginally conducive for slow development over the next few days as it moves westward to west-northwestward at 15 to 20 mph.
- By the latter part of this week, the system is expected to slow down and turn more northwestward, and a tropical depression could form.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Medium (40%)
