


## Tropical Activity Atlantic – Disturbance 1

- The remnants of a weak low-pressure area that moved inland along the Georgia coastline last night are located just inland near the Georgia/South Carolina border and are producing a few showers and thunderstorms.
- Significant redevelopment of this system is not expected.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (near 0%)



## Wildfire Activity California – Dixie Fire

- The largest wildfire burning in California is expected to make another dangerous run this week as high temperatures and gusty winds threaten to reignite smoldering fuels in the rough terrain and push sparks past containment lines.
- Roaring in remote parts of Butte and Plumas counties, the Dixie Fire had scorched more than 198,000 acres — an area larger than the size of New York City — as of Monday evening and was only 22% contained.
- The blaze has destroyed at least three dozen structures in the densely forested northeast section of the state, and another 10,700 remain in harm's way.



- More than 16,000 people are under evacuation orders in Plumas and Butte Counties.
- The Dixie Fire merged with the nearby Fly Fire this past weekend, expanding the perimeter of the blaze to at least 82 miles around the edge of the flames.
- Officials say it's now the 15th largest wildfire in state history.
