2025 Pacific Hurricane Season Outlook

- If the latest tropical weather seasonal outlooks prove accurate, both the eastern Pacific and Atlantic basins could see above-average tropical cyclone activity during the 2025 hurricane season.
- Meteorologists with the Mexican government are predicting 18 named storms in the eastern Pacific this year.
- Ten expected to become hurricanes and four reaching major hurricane status - defined as Category 3 or higher.
- Forecasters said this year's outlook is largely influenced by the status of the El Niño–Southern Oscillation, which is expected to remain in a neutral phase for much of the season.
- What remains unclear is how many of the predicted tropical cyclones will significantly impact the Mexican coastline.

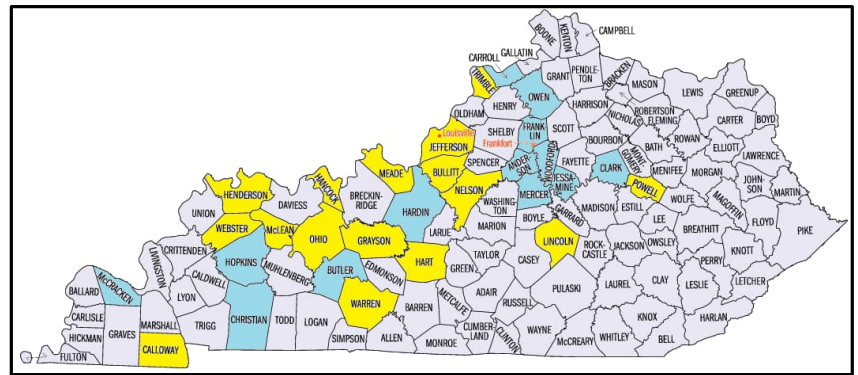

Disaster Activity

DR 4864 – Kentucky

- On April 29th, Governor Beshear submitted a request for a Major Disaster Declaration for an additional 16 counties which include: Bullitt, Calloway, Grayson, Hancock, Hart, Henderson, Jefferson, Lincoln, McLean, Meade, Nelson, Ohio, Powell, Trimble, Warren and Webster.
- At the time of the initial request, the Governor noted that more counties would be added to the declaration through an amendment process as assessments are completed.
- On April 25th, President Donald Trump approved Governor Andy Beshear's request for a major disaster declaration for Kentucky in response to the devastating April floods.
- Individual Assistance was approved for Kentuckians for the following 13 counties: Anderson, Butler, Carroll, Christian, Clark, Franklin, Hardin, Hopkins, Jessamine, McCracken, Mercer, Owen and Woodford counties that were affected by the most recent flooding.
