

Tropical Activity Atlantic – Tropical Storm Sean


- Tropical Storm Sean is centered more than 700 miles west-southwest of the Cabo Verde Islands and has sustained winds of 40 mph.
- The National Hurricane Center (NHC) said Sean is moving west northwestward at about 13 mph and is expected to continue toward the west-northwest or northwest during the next few days.
- Tropical Storm Sean is not expected to strengthen much over the coming days, likely remaining a lowend tropical storm.





Atlantic - Disturbance 1

- A tropical disturbance just offshore of western Africa is producing a large area of disorganized showers and thunderstorms.
- Some gradual development of this system is possible over the next several days while it moves westward across the eastern and central tropical Atlantic.
- According to the NHC, the disturbance has a low chance of development over the next seven days.
- Formation chance through 48 hours...low...20 percent.
- Formation chance through 7 days...low...30 percent.

Western Pacific – Super Typhoon Bolaven

- Located 290 miles NNW of Saipan; 330 miles NNW of Rota; 365 miles NNW of Guam moving NNW at 14 mph.
- Around 117 people in the Northern Mariana Islands and 437 people across Guam had evacuated to public shelters due to the storm. Shelters in Guam closing today and only 2 occupants remain in a shelter in the CNMI.
- Damage assessments are ongoing across Guam and the Northern Mariana Islands as of Oct. 11;
 initial reports indicate no major damage or casualties have occurred.
- Authorities in Rota have confirmed that the entire island was without power as of the afternoon of Oct. 10; all power has been restored.
- Port authorities in Guam resumed operations at the island's ports Oct. 11 and schools are due to reopen Oct. 12; other services across Guam and the Northern Mariana Islands are beginning to resume normal operations following the passing of the storm.
- The Office of the Governor issued a Cancellation of Storm Conditions for Tinian, Rota, and Saipan while an issue of Tropical Storm Condition 1 remained for the Northern Islands.
