Snow

Great Lakes

- Cities and towns from the Great Lakes region to parts of the Northeast are bracing for more snow and strong winds.
- The strongest clipper in the ongoing parade will charge in on Monday night.
- A potential for dangerous snow squalls with whiteout conditions and strong wind gusts up to 60 mph.
- Nearly 27 million people are under High Wind Warnings or Wind Advisories from Chicago and Milwaukee eastward through portions of Michigan, Pennsylvania and upstate New York.
- Snow and strong winds are expected to begin by Monday evening. Snow will continue to move south and east throughout the day Tuesday.
- Buffalo and Watertown in New York are once again in the bull's-eye for locally heavy snow.
