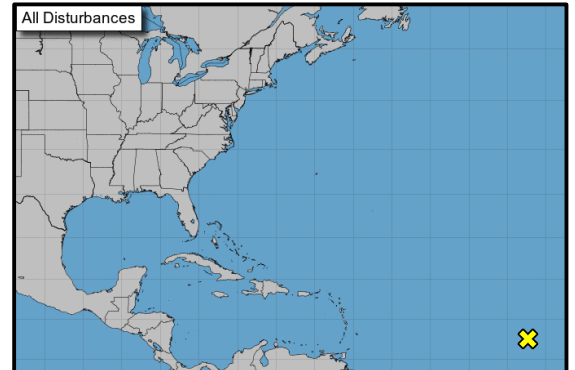

Tropical Activity

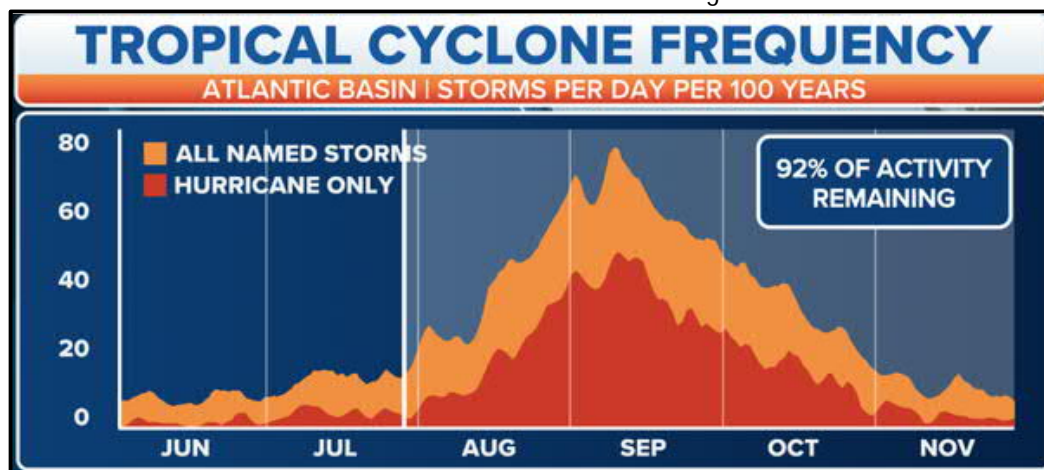
Atlantic - Disturbance 1

- A tropical disturbance in the central Atlantic is still being monitored for possible development after rolling off the western coast of Africa last weekend, but the odds of it becoming a tropical depression are increasingly unlikely.
- Satellite observations show the tropical disturbance is located about 800 miles west-southwest of the Cabo Verde Islands.
- It's currently moving west-northwestward at 15 to 20 mph across the tropical Atlantic.
- This tropical disturbance's associated shower and thunderstorm activity remains disorganized on Thursday because of Saharan dust and dry air just to the north.



Peak of Atlantic hurricane season begins in August

- The Atlantic Basin is just beginning to enter the heart of the hurricane season, which usually kicks off in mid-August and runs through mid-October. Sept. 10 is the official peak of the Atlantic hurricane season.
- During the climatological peak, it is typical for meteorologists to be tracking several disturbances across the Atlantic.
- Water temperatures are usually at their warmest, and atmospheric conditions allow for the development of persistent thunderstorm activity.
- Just in the last five years – from 2017 through 2021 – the U.S. was struck by four hurricanes in August, five in September and four in October. That included last year's Hurricane Ida, which devastated parts of southeastern Louisiana after making landfall as a Category 4 hurricane on Aug. 29.
- Forecasters at Colorado State University and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration believe the season is still on track to be more active than average.
