

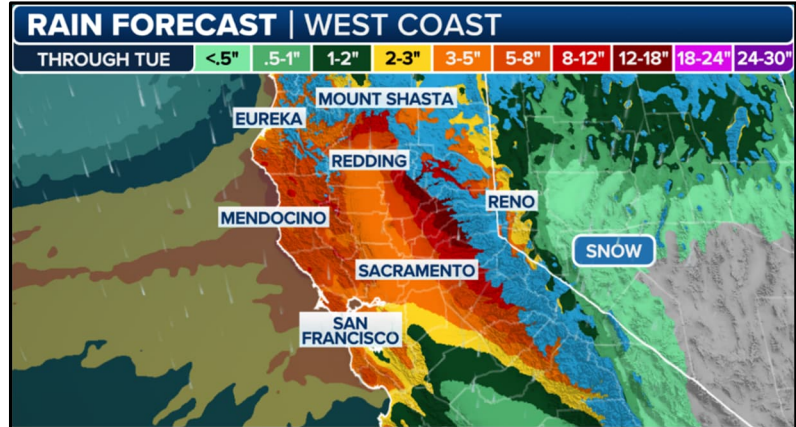

January 31, 2025

Atmospheric River California

- A series of atmospheric river events promise to deliver heavy precipitation across Northern California and the Pacific Northwest.
- The first round of significant precipitation will begin on Friday, with additional waves of moisture through the weekend and into the upcoming workweek.
- Forecasters say because the air mass originates near Hawaii, which is commonly referred to as a "Pineapple Express," the overall event will be warmer.
- The moisture will train over the Bay Area and points northward, producing widespread amounts of at least 6 inches of precipitation.
- Some river levels across the region are already elevated, leading to a greater risk that waterways could overrun their banks.
