## Severe Weather Outlook

### Eastern U.S.

- A broad severe weather threat covers parts of the Southeast through parts of Maine Thursday.
- NOAA's Storm Prediction Center has issued a risk of severe thunderstorms covering the densely populated metro areas of Washington, D.C., Baltimore, Philadelphia, and Newark, New Jersey.
- Threats also cover New York City and a wide swathe of the Northeast, as well as parts of Virginia and North Carolina to the south.
- Damaging wind gusts of up to 60 mph are expected to be the mode of severe weather threat.
- According to FOX Forecast Center there is a chance of a few tornadoes from New York City north to Burlington, Vermont.



## Severe Weather Activity

### Ohio Valley

- Severe thunderstorms moved across the central U.S. on Wednesday, producing damaging wind gusts across hundreds of communities with nearly 500,000 power outages.
- The most significant impacts were reported in Missouri, Illinois, Indiana, and Ohio, where a powerful convective system produced wind gusts exceeding 62 mph, heavy rainfall, and at least one confirmed tornado.
- In Missouri, the National Weather Service (NWS) confirmed an EF-1 tornado touched down near Clarksville in Pike County at 10:55 local time.
- The Storm Prediction Center (SPC) received reports of at least 10 tornadoes across four states during the outbreak.
- 7 confirmed tornadoes in Illinois across Morgan, Cass, Mason, Tazewell, and De Witt counties.
