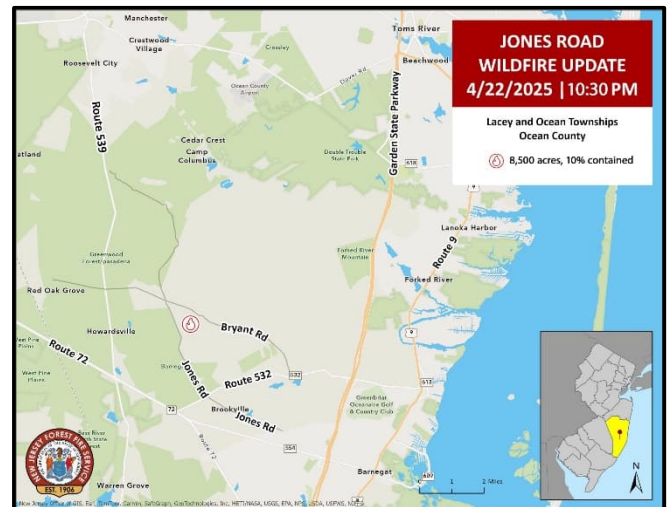
## Severe Weather Outlook Central U.S.

- Parts of the Southern Plains were slammed with severe storms on Tuesday evening, the first of a two-night severe weather threat for parts of the region.
- Severe Thunderstorm Warnings dotted western Texas into Oklahoma, with even a few Tornado Warnings.
- Wednesday, the threat of severe weather extends across the Central U.S., with the greatest chances in eastern New Mexico and the Texas Plains.
- Hail and damaging winds will again be the main threats from any severe thunderstorms that develop.
- "Multiple locations are going to be under the threat for flash flooding as we head into the next several days," FOX Weather Meteorologist Kendall Smith warned. Many areas could see 2-3 inches of rain with isolated spots reaching 5 inches.



## Wildfire Activity New Jersey

- The Jones Road Wildfire sparked in the Greenwood Forest Wildlife Management Area near Barnegat Township in Ocean County and quickly exploded in size, nearly tripling its acreage in a short period of time.
- As of Wednesday, it had consumed about 8,500 acres and was only 10% contained.
- The fire threatens more than 1,320 structures, leading to authorities' decision to order evacuations for more than 3,000 residents.
- More than 25,000 people were without power in Ocean County as of Wednesday, according to FindEnergy.com.
- The cause of the fire is under investigation and damage assessments are underway, the service reported.
- New Jersey Acting Gov. Tahesha Way declared a State of Emergency in Ocean County starting at 8 a.m. due to the ongoing response to the Jones Road Wildfire.
