

Severe Weather Outlook

- Another round of severe weather is expected to blast states 15 states from
 the Northeast and mid-Atlantic to the Southeast on Monday, placing millions of people along
 the Interstate 95 corridor at risk of damaging wind gusts, large hail and even an
 isolated tornado.
- NOAA's Storm Prediction Center (SPC) has placed an area from central New Jersey through northern South Carolina at a level 2 out of 5 on its thunderstorm risk scale.
- The main risks from severe weather that develops on Monday include damaging wind gusts and large hail, with millions of people from Philadelphia through Baltimore, Washington, Virginia Beach in Virginia and Charlotte in North Carolina seeing the highest risk.
- A tornado or two could also develop from some of the stronger storms, and that risk extends from Philadelphia through Baltimore, Washington, Virginia Beach and Norfolk, Virginia.



Severe Weather Activity Mississippi (June 18-19)

- The Mississippi Emergency Management Agency completed damage assessment validations in Jackson and Jasper Counties following severe weather from June 18-19, 2023.
- MEMA is now requesting FEMA Region IV to validate those assessment numbers; FEMA's numbers must be used to request a Major Disaster Declaration for individual assistance.
- Jackson County: 377 homes/apartments damaged.
- Jasper County: 51 homes damaged.
