## Tropical Activity Atlantic - Disturbance 1

- Cloudiness and showers associated with a broad trough of low pressure located several hundred miles southsoutheast of Bermuda remain disorganized.
- Environmental conditions are forecast to remain unfavorable, and significant development of this system is not expected.
- The disturbance is forecast to move slowly northnorthwestward or northward during the next couple of days.
- Formation chance through 48 hours...low...near 0 percent.
- Formation chance through 5 days...low...near 0 percent.



## Tropical Rainstorm Texas

- Meteorologists warn that a tropical system will continue to bring flooding rainfall through southern Texas and northern Mexico in the coming days before impacting yet another portion of the United States midweek.
- On Saturday, pockets of convection existed across the northwest Gulf of Mexico and Texas coast, although the storm's appearance was rather disorganized.

- On Sunday morning, more persistent rounds of rainfall began to push into the southern Texas coast.
- As of early Monday morning, Port Aransas, Texas, located right on the Gulf Coast, reported over 5 inches of rainfall. The Corpus Christi area reported a general 2 to 4 inches of rain during that time, however heavy rain continues to fall in the city, with a Flash Flood Warning currently in effect.
- A wide swath of heavy rain is likely to follow the path of the storm, totaling as much as 4-8 inches (100-200 mm) from southern Texas into northern Mexico.
- Heavy rainfall is expected to be the main impact from the tropical system, threatening flooding along its westward path.
- AccuWeather meteorologists warn that the rainstorm will still have the potential to bring a few stronger wind gusts and even an isolated tornado.
- On Sunday afternoon, a tornado warning was issued in a portion of southeastern Texas that included Katy, Texas.
