

Declaration Update

<u>4586 Texas</u>

- On Monday, the Federal Emergency Management Agency added 31 more Texas counties to the major disaster declaration for individual assistance, meaning residents in 108 Texas counties overall now have access to federal help for damages caused from the winter storm. The White House initially approved 77 counties for individual assistance.
- Counties included in Monday's announcement include Anderson, Austin, Bosque, Bowie, Burnet, Cherokee, Colorado, Erath, Fannin, Freestone, Gonzales, Grayson, Gregg, Harrison, Hill, Houston, Hunt, Jackson, Jim Wells, Jones, Limestone, Lubbock, Medina, Milam, Navarro, Rusk, Taylor, Tom Green, Val Verde, Washington, and Wood.



- Water restoration continues and over 9.8 million people remain under boil water notices.
- Over 10k customers remain without power in Texas.
