

Severe Weather Outlook

- The last stop for the system responsible for the severe weather and snow will be the Northeast.
- While northern Maine can expect primarily snow, ice will be the concern in Upstate New York, northern Vermont, northern New Hampshire and central Maine.
- As much as one-half inch of ice can accumulate in the most significant ice



• Meanwhile, up to a foot of snow is forecast to blanket parts of Ontario, Quebec, northern Maine and portions of Atlantic Canada.
